- ◆ Thursday September 17- Depart Escanaba to fly to San Antonio, TX

- ◆ Saturday September 19—**Texas Hill Country & LBJ Ranch Tour:** Today we board a private guided motor coach that will take us on a scenic tour of the backroads of the Texas Hill Country. We will visit LBJ Ranch at the Lyndon B Johnson National Historic Park. We will see award-winning wineries on our way to Fredericksburg, a picturesque German town where you can shop, wine taste and enjoy lunch on your own.
- ◆ Sunday September 20 — On your free day, explore the city. Visit the Historic Market where the culture of San Antonio comes alive. The Shops at La Cantera feature an impressive assortment of high-end retailers and dining choices. Many theaters and museums within walking distance of the hotel: Buckhorn Museum, Majestic Theater, Arneson River Theatre, Institute of Texan Cultures, San Antonio Art Museum and more! Explore the Missions of San Antonio which are part of UNESCO World Heritage site. Visit San Antonio's IMAX theater which boasts the biggest screen in Texas.
- ◆ Monday September 21—Say goodbye to San Antonio as we depart for home and delight in the friends and memories we have made.

San Antonio Missions National Historical Park is located about three miles from Downtown San Antonio. It consists of four missions: Concepcion, San Jose, San Juan and Espada. The Missions were built in the 1700s to expand Spanish influence from Mexico to the North. They were built as Indian towns, and the Catholic Church functioned as
